- Participating in various fundraisers throughout the year

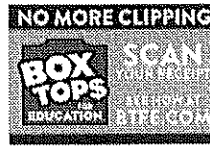

Box Tops Update

NEW BOX TOPS LABELS!



You may have noticed a new Box Tops label on products. Traditional Box Tops clips are being phased out of production. Here's what you need to know!

Eventually the Box Tops program will become digital-only. Participating brands are starting to change their packaging from a traditional Box Tops clip to the new Box Top label. If you see this label, use the new Box Tops app to scan your receipt. **Box Tops are still worth 10¢ each for your school.** The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online. They also have opportunities to earn more money for your school by purchasing certain products. The app is free of charge! More information at BTFE.com.
