Minutes of Curriculum Committee Meeting

January 24, 2022

Curriculum Committee Chairperson, Meredith Sauer, called the meeting to order at 4:07 p.m. Curriculum Committee Members Kathy Willis and Stacy Soeldner were present along with Superintendent Mark Holzman and Board of Education member Lisa Johnston. In addition, Jason Bull, Director of Teaching, Learning, and Assessment, Pam Lensmire, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, and Lori Williams, K-12 Math Specialist, were also present. Bonnie Prosenyak and Ashley Waniger from the Lincoln High School School-to-Work Office were present for a portion of the meeting, as well.

Academic & Career Planning (ACP) Update

Jason Bull, Bonnie Prosenyak, the Youth Apprentice Coordinator, and Ashley Waniger, the School to Work Coordinator, provided an overview of our 6-12 ACP processes .

- Jason Bull shared an overview of the 6-8 ACP process. This process is guided by eight pillars that include:
 - ACP Introduction
 - Keys to Successful Transitions
 - Roles and Responsibilities
 - Learning Styles Inventory
 - Career Exploration
 - Academic Course Planning
 - Academic and Career Planning Conference
- Bonnie Prosenyak and Ashley Waniger provided an overview of the 9-12 ACP process. The high school ACP process aims to guide student reflection, engagement and planning for Community, Career and College readiness and includes activities such as:
 - Goal Setting
 - Course Planning
 - Career Assessments
 - Job Fairs
 - Mock Interviews
 - Resume Writing
 - College Exploration

Secondary Mathematics Update

Lori Williams and Jason Bull provided an overview of the work the middle school math coaches completed around developing a proposed criteria for compacted math, defining what enrichment means in middle level math and the pathway to grow enrichment opportunities for all learners, identifying pathways to upper level math in high school, and outlining the professional development that staff would need to be able to provide higher level math instruction. Discussion points and questions posed will be brought back to the middle level math coaches, math teachers and administrators for review and revision. Lori Williams and Jason

Bull will bring a secondary mathematics proposal to the members of the Curriculum Committee no later than March for consideration.
