

# PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES December 8, 2021

Committee Members Present: Kerry Trask, Meredith Sauer, Stacey Soeldner Others Present: Board Members Lisa Johnston and Kathy Willis, Director of Human Resources Joyce Greenwood-Aerts

The meeting was called to order at 3:08pm by Kerry Trask. The meeting was recorded for the purpose of posting on the MPSD website.

Ms. Greenwood-Aerts shared a Human Resources update via a Google Slide Presentation that included the following topics and highlights: (Note: more detail can be found in the actual google slide presentation available in boardook)

## 1. Employer Sponsored Clinic

- Benefit to any employee/spouse/dependent on the MPSD health insurance plan
- Employer sponsored clinic in place since 2015
- No cost to the employee
  - Acute conditions, lab work, physical therapy, vaccinations, management of chronic conditions
- Annual Cost to MPSD: \$125,000
- Transitioning the employer sponsored clinic from Aurora to HF/Froedtert effective January 3, 2022

### 2. Staffing Process Overview: Classroom and Specialist Teachers

- Comprehensive timeline with processes / deadlines for elementary, middle school and high school staffing
- January April of each year
- Staffing levels driven by 1) student enrollment, and 2) student course selection (Middle School and High School level)
- Additional positions were added in 2021-22 utilizing ESSER dollars
- By mid / end of March: begin posting teacher positions for the following school year
- April: preliminary staffing report to the Personnel Committee

### 3. Substitute Teachers

- Labor shortage and COVID significant contributors to a smaller pool of substitute teachers
- Ramped up recruitment efforts
- Developed / implemented an internal plan to reduce the need for sub teachers in our buildings to offset the shortage of sub teachers

 Buildings have protocols in place when they need to fill a teacher absence with someone in their building (when a sub is not available)

#### 4. 2022-23 Draft School Calendar

- Created two options for a draft 2022-23 School Calendar
- Shared with Principals to garner feedback
- Feedback from other Stakeholders
- Goal: bring 2022-23 recommended school calendar to the personnel committee in February

This concluded the open session of the Personnel Committee Meeting.
