Staff Travel	Members of the Curriculum Committee discussed the opportunity for the K-12 Literacy Specialist to engage in the Coaching Institute on Reading K-8 Teachers College in NYC, October 21-October 24, 2018. The goal of the institute is to prepare our MPSD Literacy Specialist to enhance her coaching skills and support professional development for staff in implementation of the Reading and Writing Units of Study. The estimated cost of this learning opportunity is \$2400. A second request discussed by the committee was the opportunity for two Gr. 1 MPSD professionals to engage in the Reading and Writing Project - K-1 Phonics Teachers College in NYC, October 25-October 27, 2018. The goal of this institute is to help MPSD teacher leaders to become trained in the implementation of a phonics curriculum aligned to the Reading and Writing Units of Study so that they can provide in-district staff development. The estimated cost of this learning opportunity is \$4800. The staff travel requests were discussed and approved with a motion by Keith Shaw, a second by Dave Nickels and full approval by the all members of the Curriculum Committee.
